




my ‘Wall of Shite’

- The shelving system is called ‘Confetti C11’ and was designed by Per Bäckström in 2009 (ish).
- My ‘Wall of Shite’ consists of three Confetti C11 modules containing 12 shelves in total.
- Each shelf contains a number of objects I have collected. Some of the items have been presented here.
- On the following slide, the shelves are numbered. Pick a number.



shelf 01

- **Scientific test tube bought from salvage shop.**
- **Etched Apothecary bottle containing sulphur bought from salvage shop.**



shelf 02

- Apothecary bottle without stopper marked 'LIGHT PETROLEUM BELOW 40°' using etching.
- Dust.



shelf 03

- Advertising printing plate, late 1950's, early 1960's featuring contemporary illustration advertising fish sauce. Bought from car boot sale.
- Advertising printing plate, late 1950's, featuring Saladin and Vebol oils, manufactured by the British edible Oils Limited (Telephone Birkenhead 2411).
- Green textured cast glass tray, 1940's, 1950's, bought from collectors market.



shelf 04

- **5 1/4" floppy disk 'Video for Schools pH Titrations' for BBC Microcomputer.**
- **Wittner 'Taktell Super Mini' portable metronome.**
- **Acrylic moulded block used in (probably) screenprinting.**



shelf 05

- (not seen) Copper etched halftone printing plate featuring an early computer system used in sound recording.
- Printing plate featuring satirical cartoon of 'the Blackpool Taxpayer cash cow'.
- Copperplate etching of an Edwardian gentleman.
- Moulded glass bowl with damage to the lower edge of the rim.



shelf 06

- **Medicine bottle featuring a scale of measure in tablespoons, found in earth removed from a pipeline excavation.**
- **Unmarked medicine bottle found in earth removed from a pipeline excavation.**
- **Etched Apothecary bottle with stopper marked 'NITRIC ACID DILUTE C215'.**



shelf 07

- **Reproduction Stylophone 'Model S1'** featuring MP3 port, volume control and three sound modes.
- **Vintage early 1970's 'White Model' Stylophone as used by David Bowie in 'Space Oddity'.**



shelf 08

- **Reproduction press photograph of Stanhill Ring Mill, 1930's.**
- **Rabone 'warranted boxwood' 24" folding measure no.1167.**



shelf 09

- **MoMA acrylic perpetual calendar bought in NY and presented on my 40th birthday in BLT Prime, 1032 Lexington after a \$60 steak.**
- **(not seen) Brass and enamelled Vespa plaque in the style of Raymond Savignac bought at a Volkswagen Autojumble. Not sure what it is or what it could be used for.**

- **Gunners Prism from Cruiser Tank Mk VIII Cromwell (A27M) approx 1943.**
- **Brian Eno and Peter Schmidt's Oblique Strategies (5th edition) approx 2001.**



shelf 11

- **Vintage 'Contraband' card game from 1960.**
- **James Keiller antique stoneware marmalade jar, date unknown.**
- **Vintage Rowntree's Elect Cocoa tin.**
- **Bulgarian .22 shell casing.**
- **Sculpted naive house by S.D. Hargreaves.**
- **Shell from Madeira.**
- **Assorted quartz, granite and copper ore stones.**



shelf 11 (cont.)

- Printing block featuring a revolver bought on Camden Lock in 1992.
- Shard of shrapnel retrieved from Formby Beach.
- Printing block featuring a Series 2 Lambretta bought on Camden Lock.
- Lead wedge found in brickwork.
- 1857 agricultural show medal for 'Best Threshing Machine'.
- Just a button, discovered in the garden. We thought it was an old coin. It wasn't.



shelf 12

- **Dragon by S.D. Hargreaves.**
- **Grandma Canna's Penguin.**
- **Cotton Bale Stencilling Stamps in brass, numbers 0, 3, 5 and 9.**
- **Fossilised Sphenopsid stem found at Dinkley Bridge.**
- **Sculptural Catalytic Converter remnants, discovered on the floor in Unit 27, Albert Mill.**
